Women Graduate Students: Scholarship Opportunity

UCSB women international graduate students are welcome to apply for the P.E. O International Peace Scholarship. The scholarship is open to women students who are not U.S. or Canadian citizens. Applicants must have a full year of graduate course work left to complete and must promise to return to their home country within 60 days of completion of their degree to pursue their professional career. (Note: Those planning to remain in the U.S. to work on Optional Practical Training should not apply.) Students must file an eligibility form by December 15, 2008. If you are determined to be eligible, you will be sent an application that must be completed by January 21, 2009. APPLY FOR SOCIAL SECURITY CARD, October 3, 9:00 – 11:00 a.m.

A representative from the Social Security Office will be in OISS on Friday, October 3 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. to take applications for social security cards. Non-immigrants who wish to apply for a social security card must bring with them

1. their passport,
2. I-94 card (small white card issued when you entered the U.S.)
3. I-20 or DS-2019 form.

In addition to bringing the documents listed above, applicants will need to do and/or bring the following depending on their visa type:

- A. **F-1 visa students** must be registered for a full-course of study, have a job at the time of the application and have an employment verification letter signed by your employing department. The employment verification letter can be downloaded at :

- B. **J-1 visa students** must be registered for a full course of study.
- C. **J-1 visa scholars** must bring a letter from their employing department on department letterhead that states you need a Social Security number in order for the department to pay you.
